MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

Howrah Sanskrit Sahitya Samaj (HSSS),

Background:

HSSS, an institution dedicated to the preservation and dissemination of ancient manuscripts, possesses a rich collection of over 5000 texts covering Smrti, Nyaya, Kavya, and Vyakarana. Recognizing the importance of safeguarding this cultural heritage, HSSS has partnered with BRC, a distinguished center with a profound commitment to the preservation of cultural and philosophical heritage. BRC, known for its expertise in manuscript preservation, cataloguing, and digitization, aligns perfectly with the mission of HSSS. This collaboration aims to combine the scholarly resources of HSSS with the technical proficiency of BRC to ensure the comprehensive preservation and dissemination of these invaluable manuscripts.

132 HSSS hosts over 5000 ancient manuscripts on Smrti, Nyaya, Kavya, and Vyakarana.

1.2 BRC will undertake preservation, cataloguing, and digitization in accordance with the guidelines of the National Manuscript Mission.

Time Period:

2.1 The project duration shall be one year, commencing from March 2024 to February 2025.

Team:

- 3.1 The project will be led by Dr. Nirmalya Narayan Chakraborty and Dr. Ratna Basu.
- 3.2 A supervisor from HSSS will oversee daily progress on-site.
- 3.3 Two personnel with appropriate experience for manuscript digitization will be recruited.

Details:

- 4.1 HSSS operates six days a week, from 11:30 am to 5:30 pm (closed on Tuesdays).
- 4.2 BRC will issue appointment letters and ID cards for the appointed personnel.
- 3.3 A dedicated room will be provided by HSSS for digitization.
- 4.4 BRC will provide a Czur ET 16 scanner and a computer for digitization.

Book Digitization Process:

- 5.1 Manuscripts will undergo the following process:
 - Physically cleaned
 - Digitized
 - Watermarked with the logos of HSSS and "Digitized by BRC"
 - Catalogued

Entered in a physical register

At the end of each day, both parties will sign the register confirming the number of digitized manuscripts returned to the manuscript room.

Outcome:

6.1 Phase 1:

- Digitized, watermarked, and catalogued copies of the manuscripts.
- One copy each will be shared with HSSS and BRC
- Discussion on digital libraries, publication and sales will be after the first phase.

6.2 Phase 2:

- Creation of a digital library (similar to www.darshanmanisha.org) .
